Deaf ABE Learner Privacy Rights

The Minnesota Data Protection Act promises the following rights:

- **You** have the right to keep some information private.
- **Deaf ABE** has the right to ask you for basic information to help us serve you.
- **Deaf ABE** has the right to share some information if the law requires it **or** if you sign a release of information.

Why do you ask for personal and educational information?

- To tell you from other students with the same name.
- To determine which of our services are appropriate for you.
- To receive state and federal funds to help you.
- To refer you to other services if you need them.

Who will we share the information with?

Others involved in your education, including:

- You
- Deaf ABE staff
- Other ABE/GED providers
- Other school districts
- County Social Services/Welfare offices
- Vocational & technical schools or colleges
- Any private agency which referred you to our program

How long will we keep the information?

After you leave the program, we will keep you file until state and federal laws let us destroy it.
